Subject: DL-Windows Holiday Planning Worksheet

Models: DL-Windows V4.1.96 (other versions similar)

This Tech Tip assumes that the user understands how to create a day-to-day access schedule and is now ready to configure holiday dates and times.

The basic concept for scheduling a holiday is to set up a new Time Zone and link it to an event that will suppress your normally scheduled event. Here are some examples:

Normal Schedule For this EVENT and START TIME	Holiday Schedule Use this EVENT and START TIME (Remember to clear the stop time for this event)	
UNLOCK at 8:00am	LOCK at 8:00am	
ENABLE USER at 8:00am	DISABLE USER at 8:00am	
ENABLE GROUP at 8:00am	DISABLE GROUP at 8:00am
